Grand Coteau the 18th February 1855

Dear Brother:

Can you believe that Paul has not answered my letter yet. I am not going to write to him any more until I receive an answer. I had the happiness to see my uncle St. Clair, he told me that Madame Valcour Aime was dead. I felt very sorry and Maolan Roman the same. It was the only aunt she had from her father's side. She made a communion for her and I also pray for her. I heard that my dear uncle Chevalier was dying. You must pray for him. I received your last letter. Tell Paul that I told my uncle that he never writes to me. He will give him a good scolding.
