PERSONAL LETTER to Alexandre Declouet at Brookland Academy in Greenwood Depot, Virginia, from his cousin, Alexandre Frere (?), in Grand Coteau.

March 27, 1857

Dear Cousin,

I have just received a letter from you and I have made haste to answer you I suppose you will answer me also.

I have not many news to give you this time, only that I went to the Convent (Sacred Heart Convent in Grand Coteau) yesterday and saw your sister (Blanche Declouet). She seems to be in a very good health.

Agricole never wrote to me since I am here. I will not write to him if he does not write me.

You will find a small letter this time.

Goodbye dear cousin, give my best respects to Paul (Declouet).
