PERSONAL LETTER from Alexander Declouet, Jr., in St. Martinville, to his brother, Paul Declouet, at Brookland School in Greenwood Depot, Virginia.

St. Martinville, 26th of February 1860

Dear Paul,

I have just arrived this morning from Cuba. Enclosed I send you a letter for Schaumburg. Send it to him as soon as you can. I found every body well here.

You must excuse this short note; have not time at present to write longer.

Nearly all the furniture has arrived. Goodbye. I will write you a long letter very soon.
