TERMS

Exclusive of Lights and Towels, \$280 per Session, to be paid in advance,
\$140 on the 1st of September, and \$140 on the 1st of February.

Pupils who enter at any time within the first month of the session
will pay the full charge for the whole session. Those who enter after the
first month will pay at the rates of \$30 per month. Pupils are considered as
engaged from the date of their entrance to the end of the session. In cases of
withdrawal except for protracted sickness, or other unavoidable necessity, no
claim for refunding board or tuition will be allowed, except at the discretion
of the Principal. In cases of dismissal or expulsion, only the board for the
time lost will be refunded, at the rate of \$15 per month.

Parents and Guardians are earnestly requested to limit the
allowance of pocket money to their boys to \$5 per month, or less. The
Principal, if desired, will receive and distribute deposits for this purpose.

DEALING ON CREDIT will not be allowed without express written requests from parents or guardians to the Principal, and written order from the Principal to the stores.

At the examinations held at the close of each term of five months, pupils must attain to, at least, the second division in all their classes, to continue in school the following term, unless a satisfactory excuse for their failure is given.
